


## Online Learning: 11<sup>th</sup> - 15<sup>th</sup> January 2021

### Tryfan Class

*Our theme for this term is SPACE!*



Listen to the story 'There's no place like Space'.

Once you have listened to the story, with an adult have a try at some of these activities over the next few days.

- In the story the Cat in the Hat visits all the planets in our solar system. Can you remember the order of the planets? Write a list of the planets in order. Can you make up your own rhyme to help you remember the order of the planets?



- All of the planets in our solar system are different sizes. Can you find out their size and put them in size order from the smallest to largest? You could ask a grown up to help you draw them or write the name of each planet.
- One full day on Earth is 24 hours, we have night and day. Can you find out what days and nights are like on some of the other planets?



- What do you like to do in the daytime? Draw a picture of yourself doing one of your favourite things. What about at night? What do you do before you go to bed? Can you draw me a picture?

- I know lots of you really like animals! Did you know that some animals only come out at night? We call these nocturnal animals. Can you find out about some nocturnal animals? You could draw a picture of the animal and write about it.



- Some planets are hot, some are cold? I wonder why? Can you find out for me? Which is the hottest planet, which is the coldest?
- You could watch this video on you tube to help you learn about our solar system, it might help you with some of your activities.
