Once you have listened to the songs with an adult have a try at some of these activities over the next few days.

The sunshine makes everyone feel happy, can you brighten up your day by making your own sun.


You can create your sun in lots of different ways –

Ask an adult to cut out a big yellow circle, you can then snip around the edges to create the sun's rays.



You could paint the sun using yellow and orange paint, scrunch up tissue paper and dab it on the paper to make you sun look extra bright. You can then create the sun's rays using lines of Cheerio's

Ask an adult to cut out a big yellow circle and punch holes around the outside. Can you use string or wool to thread in and out of the holes to create the sun's rays?



Once you have made your sun count how many rays you have made, can you make one more? How many do you have now?


S is for Sun – what else is S for? Ask your adult to make a feely bag and fill it with items from around the house that begin with the sound S. Can you feel each item and guess what it is? Can you fill the bag and ask your adult to guess. For an extra challenge put some items that do not begin with S in the bag, can you find them?

The sun gives us light and keeps us warm;

### Light

When the sun's light is interrupted it creates a shadow, can you create a shadow?

You could, build a rocket out of blocks, Lego or cardboard boxes and take it outside to see if you can make a shadow. Can you draw around the shadow?



Or you could make a shadow den – use a big cardboard box or a bedsheet and make a dark den. Once your den is complete find a torch and get cosy inside. Can you create hand shadows in your den? With an adult take it in turns to hold a number of fingers up, how many are there?

### Heat

In the summer the sun's rays are very strong and we have to protect our skin.

Can you think of a Superhero name?

Just for fun - Hot and cold sensory bottles;

Find two clear bottles, fill one with warm water and the other with cold. Slowly drip food colouring into each bottle. What can you see, what do you notice? The food colouring dripped into the warm water should mix quicker than the cold.



Find two clear bottles, fill one with warm water and the other with ice cubes. Explore the bottles. What do they feel like? Do they make a noise when you shake them? (Remember to glue the lids on 😊)
