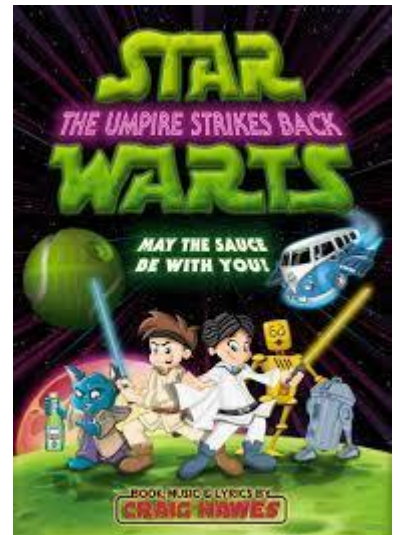


## Years 5 & 6 Concert
